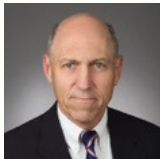
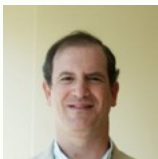


# Can the House Strengthen Civil Enforcement of Subpoenas to the Executive Branch through Rules Changes?

The executive branch has obstructed legislative information gathering with increasing frequency and effectiveness for the better part of the last two decades. Members of Congress and congressional committee staff have become increasingly frustrated by the difficulty of enforcing their constitutionally legitimate information demands and are searching for solutions to restore the efficacy of congressional investigation.
